TEEN VICTIMIZATION STATS:

Did you know....?

- Each day 5 runaways are reported, 143 each month, and 1,715 each year in the Washington metropolitan area.
- 40% of juveniles who ran away are involved in crime.
- 1 in 6 boys and 1 in 3 girls are sexually assaulted before age 18
- 163 violent victimizations against
 12-17 year old students on school grounds occur every hour
- 1 in 5 female high school students report being physically and/or sexually abused by a dating partner
- Youth between the ages of 13 and 24 are still contracting HIV at the rate of 2 per hour
