Why supervised visits or safe exchange?

Supervised Visits and Safe Exchanges allow the children to maintain a relationship with both of their parents.

They can anticipate the visits without the stress of worrying about what is going to happen, and enjoy their time in a safe, comfortable environment without being put in the middle of their parents' conflict or other problems.

Program Overview:

STEP was established to provide visitation and exchange services between divorced or separated parents. Staff helps to ensure a safe and secure setting for the child, free from parental conflict.

What is Supervised Visitation?

Supervised contact between a parent and their child(ren) in the presence of a third person who is responsible for observing (and in some cases taking notes) and ensuring the safety of those involved.

What is Supervised Exchange?

Supervision of the transfer of a child or children from one parent to the other for the evening, weekend, or holiday visits. Every precaution is taken to ensure that the individuals exchanging the child do not come into contact with one another.

Safety and Security :

Visitation Services is dedicated to ensuring the safety of everyone involved in the program; therefore, the following safety measures are in place:

- ◇ On -site security officers.
- ◇ Staggered arrival and departure times for custodial and non-custodial parents .
- ◇ Parenting tools and modules to help make visits productive and family friendly.

CAFY reserves the right to refuse services when they cannot be conducted in a safe and amicable way.

VISITATION:

Visitation rooms are set up in a comfortable environment with a variety of toys and games that allow for positive parent/child interaction. Visits and exchanges are scheduled between the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Wednesdays and Fridays.

EXCHANGE/ TRANSFER:

Transfers/ Exchanges :

- ◇ Wednesdays & Fridays 5pm-7:30pm
- ◇ Sundays 12pm-3pm

FEES FOR VISITATION SERVICES

Intake/Orientation: \$15 per parent

Supervised Visitation: \$40 per hour. Some sliding scale spots available based on need.

Safe Exchange: \$15 per parent per weekend exchange

Late Cancellation/No Show \$20

Special consideration may be available for extreme crisis
